PERFORMANCE

Four dissidents from the former Soviet Union are stranded in the interzonal area between East and West; Nostalgia, psychological malfunctions, and desperate social needs create a far from harmonious atmosphere, But the essential question remains – should they continue towards the unknown or should they go back to what they know?

THERE was originally made in 2001. With a mixed cast of dancers and actors, the performance exhibits a mix of modern dance, slapstick humor and interpersonal conflicts, and has been described as an evocation of Beckett's "Waiting for Godot". 13 years after its premiere, the company sets out on yet another quest to pinpoint human insecurity.

LANGUAGE

THERE initiated the company's NONSENSICAL LANGUAGE

trademark, from where on Jo Stromgren Kompani created its own international niche through long-term research on abstract text. Each production involved a completely new linguistic alias, inspired by a specific culture or region, to stimulate associative interpretations instead of forcing any specific opinion upon the audience.

COMPANY

JO STRØMGREN KOMPANI was founded in 1998 and has from its base in Oslo. Norway, grown to become one of the most established independent groups in Scandinavia. The company presents 100-200 shows in 10-20 countries each year. The touring list covers 54 countries so far, frequented by a repertory of 26 stage productions and 2 movie productions. The style is characterised by a mix of dance and theatre, with puppet theatre, nonsensical language, film and live music often added. Jo Stromgren also has a successful career as a freelance choreographer, theatre director and playwright.
